


Fond du Lac Lands and Public Lands Map

Access for non-Band Members:

New in 2020: Anyone who is not an enrolled member of the Fond du Lac Band will need a permit to hunt, gather, hike, cross through, or otherwise access lands posted 'no trespassing' by the Fond du Lac Band. Note this is an access permit and not a substitute for any other required license. Violators will be subject to trespass penalties. Posted lands will include all Fond du Lac lands (anything shown as green on this map) with the exception of "Fond du Lac Conservation Lands" which will remain open to anyone (Conservation Lands are shown with a dotted-red line around the perimeter of the land parcel). ATV'ing or snowmobiling on DESIGNATED routes will not require a permit from the Band.

Permits are available from the Fond du Lac Resource Management Division. Currently permits are free for immediate family members of enrolled Band members. Others may buy an access permit: \$25 for 30-days, or \$100 for a year.
