**PUBLIC SURVEY ABOUT FOND DU LAC ROADS AND TRAILS OPENS**

FOND DU LAC RESERVATION – The Fond du Lac Planning Department invites the public to provide input about roads and trails on the Fond du Lac Reservation through a public survey. The survey can be accessed by visiting [www.ardcplanning.org/fonddulac](http://www.ardcplanning.org/fonddulac) and will be open until November 30, 2021.

This survey is part of a larger project to update the transportation plan for the Fond du Lac Reservation. An up-to-date transportation plan is required for the Fond du Lac Band of Lake Superior Chippewa to access funding for maintaining and constructing roads and trails on the Reservation. To facilitate the development of the transportation plan, the Fond du Lac Band hired ARDC Planning, which will also hold a virtual public open house to provide further public input opportunities on Monday, November 15.
