

- Referrals to homelessness prevention services
- Accessing transitional housing
- Accessing permanent supportive housing
- Other subsidized or low-income housing opportunities



Please Contact Coordinated Entry Right Away if You Are:

- Homeless right now
- Living somewhere without working utilities
- Living with a family and do not have space of your own
- Going to be homeless in 2 weeks or less

The Coordinated Entry process is for people living in Carlton County Minnesota.

If you don't live in Carlton County but need housing services, please call 2-1-1 and ask for assistance where you live.

You're One Step Closer To Housing With Coordinated Entry

- Call Monday – Friday from 8:30 – 3:30
- Ask for a “Pre-screen”
- Be ready to write down information
- Attend any appointments that are scheduled



Grievance Procedure

If there are issues with any part of the process, individuals can file a grievance. This is done by contacting the person with whom your appointment is scheduled.
